Children really enjoy working with clay. It helps develop their manual dexterity and aesthetic skills and has a proven impact on achievement across the curriculum.

Sam Paechter is a potter and qualified teacher who's been working in primary schools for fourteen years. He offers:

Year 1

workshops usually supporting topic work, in which children design and make their own individual pieces; for example portraits, animals, whistles, minibeasts, buildings, boxes, coil and thumb pots, tiles, Viking longboats, Egyptian mummies...

residencies with a whole class or school, making, for example a tiled mural showing scenes important to the community of the school, a school sign or another very large piece.

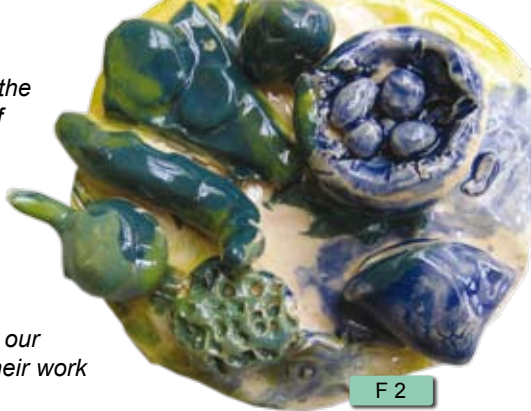
enabling teachers to set up and run a pottery curriculum within their school (often best delivered as part of a wider project).
